

Blanche Nevile Primary School - Sports Premium Statement 2019/20

For the academic 2018/19 the school will receive £16,180 PE and Sports Premium Funding. This funding is to be used to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport on offer to pupils.

We will use this funding to:

- Develop and add to existing provision
- Make improvements
- Develop partnership work with other schools
- Make explicit links with other subjects

The five key indicators of success are:

1. Regular engagement of all pupils in physical activity
2. Increased profile for PE and sport across the school
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff teaching PE and sport
4. Increased range of sports and activities on offer
5. Increased participation in competitive sport

The National Curriculum states that pupils should:

- Be physically active during and after each school day (set a target time) this excludes general playtimes
- Engage in competition
- Lead healthy lifestyles
