

Blanche Nevile Blended Learning Statement



Whenever the school is closed or partially closed because of a national lockdown the following is implemented:

Teaching and Learning:

All teachers complete weekly logs which are checked by the SLT who follow up any concerns promptly. Pupil engagement on See Saw and Google classroom is monitored daily.

Primary:

- Teachers, with the support of CSWs and LSAs, will prepare three lessons daily – English, Maths and a third curriculum area to include a weekly BSL lesson
- A broad and balanced curriculum is provided weekly and supplemented by short daily PE session
- The online platform used is 'See Saw'
- The same teaching and learning offer will be available whether pupils are at home or at school.
- Pupils will receive next steps feedback at least 3 times a week

Secondary:

- A remote learning timetable has been set for each tutor teaching group and shared with students
- A broad and balanced curriculum will be offered over the course of the ten day timetable to include a BSL lesson for all students
- The online platform used is 'Google Classroom' – students receive prompt feedback
- Core subject teachers will give 'live' feedback on Zoom once a week

Daily Registers:

These will be held:

1. To encourage pupils to be up and dressed and ready to learn each day
2. Because 'seeing' their teachers will help pupils to realise that they are learning remotely and not on an extended holiday
3. Give pupils an opportunity to 'see' each other and keep in touch

Primary:

Class teachers hold a daily 'live' register on Zoom – invites are sent to parents

Secondary:

Key stage registers are held daily on Zoom – students receive direct invites

Resources for students

- At both Primary and Secondary, teaching packs will be sent home for all students who find it difficult to access on-line learning
- The school has loaned iPads and laptops to some pupils
- Secondary students have received laptops from two different government schemes during the summer term
- We are awaiting the delivery of 13 chrome books to support home learning

Well-being:

- Senior leaders keep in regular contact to support families using a range of media
- Fortnightly Mindfulness Sessions will be available for pupils to access at a time convenient to them

We monitor the effectiveness of our blended learning provision routinely and are committed to improving our offer continuously
